He has successfully secured over £10 million in external research funding, mostly as principal investigator. Member of the Scientific Committee of the Groupe Européen de Recherches sur les Normativités (GERN). Fellow of the Academy of Social Services and a lifetime honorary member of the British Society of Criminology. From 2010-15, Editor in Chief of the journal Criminology and Criminal Justice and an Editorial Board member of the British Journal of Criminology. Member of the International Advisory Boards for the Australian and New Zealand Journal of Criminology, Criminology and Criminal Justice and Restorative Justice.
